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fuel tax refunds or as transactions between state agencies as provided by 1 this act, a written release and satisfaction of all claims and rights against

- the state of Kansas and any agencies, officers and employees of the state of Kansas regarding their respective claims.
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- Sec. 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 5 publication in the Kansas register. 6
