Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 65-407 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-7 407. No such lien shall be effective unless a written notice containing an 8 itemized statement of all setting forth the amount of all of the hospital's 9 claims, the name-and address of the injured person, the date of the accident, and the name and location of the hospital, and the name of the 10 person or persons, firm or firms, corporation or corporations alleged to be 11 12 liable to the injured party for the injuries received, shall be filed in the 13 office of the clerk of the district court of the county in which such hospital 14 is located, prior to the payment of any moneys to such injured person, his 15 such person's attorneys or legal representatives, as compensation for such 16 injuries; nor unless the hospital shall also send, by registered or certified 17 mail, postage prepaid, a copy of such notice with a statement of the date of 18 filing thereof to the person or persons, firm or firms, corporation or-19 corporations alleged to be liable to the injured party for the injuries 20 sustained prior to the payment of any moneys to such injured person, his 21 attorneys or legal representative, as compensation for such injuries. Such 22 hospital shall mail a copy of such notice to any insurance carrier which has 23 insured such person, firm or corporation against such liability, if the name 24 and address shall be known. Such hospital shall also send, by registered or 25 certified mail, a copy of such notice to such patient upon whom emergency 26 medical or other service has been performed, if the name and address of 27 such patient shall be known to the hospital or can with reasonable 28 diligence be ascertained.
