

**Substitute for SENATE BILL No. 335**

1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to vehicle registration, fees;  
2 creating the Kansas highway patrol staffing and training fund; law  
3 enforcement training center fund; amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-145  
4 and repealing the existing section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 New Section 1. There is hereby created in the state treasury, the  
8 Kansas highway patrol staffing and training fund. Moneys credited to the  
9 Kansas highway patrol staffing and training fund shall be used by the  
10 highway patrol for increasing employment and retaining personnel at the  
11 highway patrol and for no other purpose. All expenditures from the Kansas  
12 highway patrol staffing and training fund shall be made in accordance with  
13 appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports  
14 issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the superintendent of the  
15 highway patrol.

16 New Sec. 2. In addition to any registration fee prescribed under  
17 article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments  
18 thereto, all applicants for vehicle registration shall pay at the time of  
19 registration a nonrefundable Kansas highway patrol staffing and training  
20 surcharge in the amount of \$2 for each vehicle being registered.

21 New Sec. 3. In addition to any registration fee prescribed under  
22 article 1 of chapter of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments  
23 thereto, all applicants for vehicle registration shall pay, at the time of  
24 registration, a nonrefundable law enforcement training center surcharge in  
25 the amount of \$1.25 for each vehicle being registered.

26 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-145 is hereby amended to read as  
27 follows: 8-145. (a) All registration and certificates of title fees shall be  
28 paid to the county treasurer of the county in which the applicant for  
29 registration resides or has an office or principal place of business within  
30 this state, and the county treasurer shall issue a receipt in triplicate, on  
31 blanks furnished by the division of vehicles, one copy of which shall be  
32 filed in the county treasurer's office, one copy shall be delivered to the  
33 applicant and the original copy shall be forwarded to the director of  
34 vehicles.

35 (b) The county treasurer shall deposit \$.75 of each license  
36 application, \$.75 out of each application for transfer of license plate and \$2

1 out of each application for a certificate of title, collected by such treasurer  
2 under this act, in a special fund, which fund is hereby appropriated for the  
3 use of the county treasurer in paying for necessary help and expenses  
4 incidental to the administration of duties in accordance with the provisions  
5 of this law and extra compensation to the county treasurer for the services  
6 performed in administering the provisions of this act, which compensation  
7 shall be in addition to any other compensation provided by any other law,  
8 except that the county treasurer shall receive as additional compensation  
9 for administering the motor vehicle title and registration laws and fees, a  
10 sum computed as follows: The county treasurer, during the month of  
11 December, shall determine the amount to be retained for extra  
12 compensation not to exceed the following amounts each year for calendar  
13 year 2006 or any calendar year thereafter: The sum of \$110 per hundred  
14 registrations for the first 5,000 registrations; the sum of \$90 per hundred  
15 registrations for the second 5,000 registrations; the sum of \$5 per hundred  
16 for the third 5,000 registrations; and the sum of \$2 per hundred  
17 registrations for all registrations thereafter. In no event, however, shall any  
18 county treasurer be entitled to receive more than \$15,000 additional annual  
19 compensation.

20 If more than one person shall hold the office of county treasurer during  
21 any one calendar year, such compensation shall be prorated among such  
22 persons in proportion to the number of weeks served. The total amount of  
23 compensation paid the treasurer together with the amounts expended in  
24 paying for other necessary help and expenses incidental to the  
25 administration of the duties of the county treasurer in accordance with the  
26 provisions of this act, shall not exceed the amount deposited in such  
27 special fund. Any balance remaining in such fund at the close of any  
28 calendar year shall be withdrawn and credited to the general fund of the  
29 county prior to June 1 of the following calendar year.

30 (c) The county treasurer shall remit the remainder of all such fees  
31 collected, together with the original copy of all applications, to the  
32 secretary of revenue. The secretary of revenue shall remit all such fees  
33 remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A.  
34 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance,  
35 the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to  
36 the credit of the state highway fund, except as provided in subsection (d).

37 (d) (1) Three dollars and fifty cents of each certificate of title fee  
38 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the  
39 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway patrol  
40 motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each certificate of title fee collected  
41 and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state  
42 treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology  
43 hardware fund.

1 (2) For repossessed vehicles, \$3 of each certificate of title fee  
2 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the  
3 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the repossessed certificates of  
4 title fee fund.

5 (3) Three dollars and fifty cents of each reassignment form fee  
6 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the  
7 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway patrol  
8 motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each reassignment form fee collected  
9 and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state  
10 treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology  
11 hardware fund.

12 (4) Until January 1, 2013, \$4 of each division of vehicles  
13 modernization surcharge collected and remitted to the secretary of  
14 revenue, shall be remitted to the state treasurer who shall credit such \$4 to  
15 the division of vehicles modernization fund, on and after January 1, 2013,  
16 the state treasurer shall credit such \$4 to the state highway fund.

17 (5) *Two dollars of each Kansas highway patrol staffing and training*  
18 *surcharge collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be*  
19 *remitted to the state treasurer who shall credit such \$2 to the Kansas*  
20 *highway patrol staffing and training fund.*

21 (6) *One dollar and twenty-five cents of each law enforcement*  
22 *training center surcharge collected and remitted to the secretary of*  
23 *revenue, shall be remitted to the state treasurer who shall credit such*  
24 *\$.25 to the law enforcement training center fund.*

25 Sec. 5. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-145 is hereby repealed.

26 Sec. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
27 publication in the statute book.
