MR. PRESIDENT:

I move to amend **HB 2039**, as amended by House Committee, on page 1, following line 28, by inserting:

"Section 1. K.S.A. 25-2306 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-2306. The application for registration shall include a statement by the applicant that he will have reached the age of eighteen (18) years before the next statewide general election (a) Any person who passes the basic civics test or tests administered pursuant to K.S.A. 72-3217, and amendments thereto, may apply to register to vote. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, the secretary of state shall suspend such applicant's registration until such time as the person reaches 18 years of age.

- (b) The application for registration for any person who does not satisfy the requirements of subsection (a) shall include a statement by the applicant that such person will have reached 18 years of age prior to the next statewide general election.
- (c) No person may vote at any election until-he such person has reached the age of eighteen (18) 18 years of age.";

On page 2, in line 40, after "K.S.A." by inserting "25-2306 and"; also in line 40, by striking "is" and inserting "are";

And by renumbering sections accordingly;

On page 1, in the title, in line 2, after the semicolon by inserting "authorizing voter registration for individuals who pass such examination;"; in line 3, after "K.S.A." by inserting
