**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2314 by House Committee on Legislative Modernization

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2314 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2314 would prohibit the use of the social media platform TikTok on state-owned devices and on any state network. The bill would require the Chief Information Technology Officers of the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Branches to cooperate to ensure that TikTok is not being accessed on any electronic device owned or issued by the state or on any network operated by the state. The bill's provisions would not apply to state agencies that are using a state electronic device to access TikTok for law enforcement activities or cybersecurity investigations.


The Office of Information Technology Services indicates enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on agency operations.

Legislative Administrative Services indicates enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect on the operations of the Legislature.

The Office of Judicial Administration states the bill's enactment would have a fiscal effect on Judicial Branch operations because the bill's provisions would require the Judicial Branch Chief Information Technology Officer to put measures into place to ensure that TikTok is not installed

or accessed on electronic devices or networks owned by the Judicial Branch. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2314 is not reflected in *The FY 2024 Governor's Budget Report*.
