


Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA) designations identify areas, population groups, or facilities within the United States that are experiencing a shortage of health care professionals.

State and Federal agencies use HPSAs to prioritize and direct limited resources to areas with unmet primary, dental and mental health care needs.

The SOPC-RH is responsible for the collection of information from health care professionals used in the population to professional ratios. All other data used is obtained through U.S. census and other national sources.

Rules for Population Group HPSAs

Low-Income Population

• To qualify, the RSA must have > 30% of its population < 200% of the poverty level.

Medicaid-Eligible Population

To qualify, the RSA must have > 30% of its population < 200% of the poverty level.

Migrant or Seasonal Farmworker

 Designation requests should adjust the number of migrant seasonal farmworkers for the fraction of the year they are in the RSA.



Health Care Vacancies and Turnover in Kansas*

- Vacancy rates for nurse assistants (CNAs) and staff nurses have remained steady since 2022, while licensed practical nurse (LPN) vacancies have increased to an all time high of 25 percent.
- Turnover rates for LPNs and CNAs have increased slightly since last year, while Registered Nurse (RN) turnover remains steady at 20 percent.
- Highest Projected Job Openings through 2028: RNs, CNAs and Home Health Aides

Kansas' **State Loan Repayment Program** offers eligible health care professionals an opportunity to receive assistance with the repayment of qualifying educational loans in exchange for a minimum two-year service commitment to an underserved area.

From 2018 to 2022, the SOPC-RH helped 59 health care professionals pay off over \$1.3 million in student debt through the SLRP (kdhe.ks.gov/PC-RH).

Of the 59 participants, 16 percent served a frontier county, and 44 percent served in a rural county.


Nurse Corps Loan Repayment Program

The Nurse Corps offers loan repayment to nurses who work in health centers, rural health clinics, hospitals, and other facilities experiencing a critical shortage of nurses; and to nurse faculty who teach full-time in eligible public or private schools of nursing.






Primary Care HPSA Scores as of July 2023


Mental Health HPSA Scores as of July 2023
