



Kansas Medicaid: Sedation Dentistry Report

This report, generated by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) at the request of the Robert G. (Bob) Bethell Joint Committee on Home and Community Based Services and KanCare Oversight, outlines the rates paid for sedation dentistry in the Kansas Medicaid program in comparison with other states, the number of dentists using sedation dental codes, and, separately, the number of Indian Health Service (IHS) providers and Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) using sedation dental codes. The report uses data from calendar year 2023.

Kansas Sedation Dental Code Rates Compared to Other States

The below table compares Kansas Medicaid reimbursement rates for sedation dental codes to reimbursement rates for the same codes in other states.

Dentist Availability by County

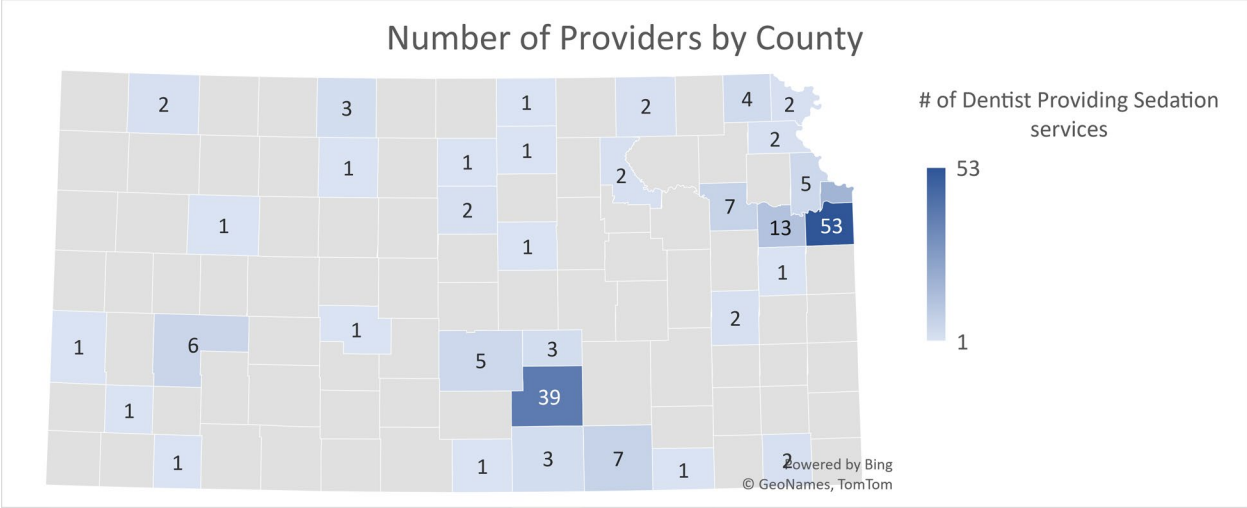
