Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 21-5420 is hereby amended to read as follows: 21-5420. (a) Robbery is knowingly taking property from the person or presence of another by force or by threat of bodily harm to any person *in the course of the taking*.

- (b) Aggravated robbery is robbery, as defined in subsection (a), when committed by a person who:
 - (1) Is armed with a dangerous weapon; or
- 14 (2) inflicts bodily harm upon any person in the course of such 15 robbery.
 - (c) For the purpose of this section, an act occurs "in the course of the taking" if the act occurs in the commission of, attempt to commit or flight from the taking.
 - (d) (1) Robbery is a severity level 5, person felony.
- 20 (2) Aggravated robbery is a severity level 3, person felony.
- 21 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 21-5420 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
