1 AN ACT concerning drainage districts; relating to the governance thereof;
2 authorizing the board of directors of such districts to hold executive
3 sessions in accordance with the open meetings act; amending K.S.A.
4 24-416 and repealing the existing section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 24-416 is hereby amended to read as follows: 24-
8 416. (a) The board of directors shall meet at least once each year. At such
9 meeting, the board shall adopt a resolution stating the time, date and place
10 of all regular meetings of the board. The resolution also shall state that if
11 the regular meeting date occurs on a Sunday or on a legal holiday or a
12 holiday specified by the board, the meeting shall be held at the same time
13 and place on the next day following the holiday. The resolution shall be
14 published once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of
15 general circulation in the county in which the district is located. Meetings
16 may be held on the call of the chairperson or at the request of a majority of
17 the members of the board. Written notice of any special meeting shall be
18 given to members of the board at least two days in advance of the meeting.
19 The notice shall specify the time, place and purpose of the special meeting.

20 (b) A majority of directors shall constitute a quorum for the
21 transaction of business, and in the absence of the presiding officer or
22 secretary, a quorum at any meeting may select a presiding officer and a
23 secretary pro tem. All meetings shall be open to the public and no meeting
24 shall be held by the board or any of the members thereof to which the
25 public is denied admission and the board shall not at any time go into
26 executive session, except that the board may meet in executive session in
27 accordance with K.S.A. 75-4319, and amendments thereto.

28 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 24-416 is hereby repealed.

29 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
30 publication in the statute book.
