1. Delete \$4.3 billion, all SGF, to remove the Kansas State Department of Education budget from HB 2802 and insert the Kansas State Department of Education budget into HB 2048 for FY 2026.

House Committee's Recommendation

The **Budget Committee** concurs with the Budget Committee's recommendation for FY 2026.

House Budget Committee's Recommendation (House Sub. for SB 387)

The **Budget Committee** concurs with the Governor's recommendation with the following adjustment:

- 1. Insert the Kansas State Department of Education budget into House Sub. for SB 387 for FY 2026.
- 2. Delete \$74.8 million SGF for the second year of the Governor's five-year step progression increase for Special Education State Aid for FY 2026.
- 3. Add language lapsing the additional \$65.5 million SGF for Special Education State Aid if the provisions regarding excess cost in Sections 5, 14, and 16 are not signed into law by the Governor for FY 2026.

House Committee of the Whole's Recommendation (House Sub. for SB 387)

The **Committee of the Whole** concurs with the Budget Committee's recommendation for FY 2026.

Conference Committee's Recommendation (House Sub. for SB 387)

The **Conference Committee** concurs with the Governor's recommendation for FY 2026 with the following adjustments:

- 1. Delete \$74.9 million SGF for the first year of the Governor's recommendation for a step progression of increases for Special Education State Aid for FY 2026.
- 2. Delete \$9.5 million SGF for Special Education State Aid to match maintenance of effort for FY 2026, leaving a total of \$601.0 million for FY 2026.
- 3. Add language lapsing \$65.5 million SGF for Special Education State Aid if the policy sections regarding excess costs are not enacted into law for FY 2026.

Omnibus Action (HB 2551)

1. Adopt GBA No. 2, Item 6, to add \$13.8 million, including deleting \$7.8 million SGF, to adopt the Spring 2024 Education Consensus Estimate for FY 2026.
