each institution certify to the State Finance Council that the institution did not engage in an Diversity, Equity and Inclusion activities for FY 2025. Add further language that funding be restored contingent on the passage of HB 2460 or similar legislation.

6. Delete \$3.5 million SGF from student aid for financial needs from each university account until the state finance council certifies that the Board of Regents has distributed the Kansas Comprehensive Grant with 50.0 percent going to state universities and 50.0 percent going to not-for-profit institutions for FY 2025.
