

2012 Kansas Statutes

23-2207. How parent and child relationship is established. The parent and child relationship between a child and:

- (a) The mother may be established by proof of her having given birth to the child or under this act.
- (b) The father may be established under this act or, in the absence of a final judgment establishing paternity, by a voluntary acknowledgment of paternity meeting the requirements of K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 23-2204, and amendments thereto, unless the voluntary acknowledgment has been revoked pursuant to K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 23-2209, and amendments thereto.
- (c) An adoptive parent may be established by proof of adoption.
