
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2626 by House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2626 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2626 would authorize the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism to allow the use of leashed tracking dogs by persons who have a hunting license and valid big game permit. The dogs could be used to track and find dead, wounded or injured big game.

According to the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism, there would be no fiscal effect from passage of HB 2626.
