**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2484**

As Recommended by House Committee on  
Federal and State Affairs

**Brief\***

HB 2484 would make changes to a disclosure provision in the Charitable Gaming Act.

The bill would clarify that the Secretary of Revenue or the Secretary's designee could release or publish charitable gaming information obtained in charitable gaming licensee and registration applications and renewals. Existing law allows the release or publication of such information for bingo licensees only. The bill would broaden this provision so information for all charitable gaming licensees, including raffle licensees, also could be released or published by the Secretary or Secretary's designee.

**Background**

The bill was introduced by the House Committee on Federal and State Affairs at the request of Representative Hineman. At the hearing before the House Committee, the Kansas Department of Revenue testified in support of the bill. There were no opposing or neutral conferees on the bill.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget on the bill, the Department of Revenue indicates the bill would have no fiscal effect.
