SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2225 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2225 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, whenever a person driving a vehicle approaches a railroad grade crossing under certain conditions, the driver is required to stop within 50 feet, but not less than 15 feet from the nearest rail of the railroad. HB 2225 would specify that a driver must stop for a train or "other on-track equipment."

Enactment of HB 2225 would have no fiscal effect.
