SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 131 by Senator Pittman


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 131 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 131 would allow funeral escorts to direct traffic for funeral processions. The bill would outline right-of-way scenarios and exceptions as well as requirements for vehicles in funeral processions.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates it cannot estimate a fiscal effect until given the opportunity to operate under the bill's provisions. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 131 is not reflected in *The FY 2022 Governor's Budget Report*.

Both the League of Kansas Municipalities and the Kansas Association of Counties state enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect for local governments.
